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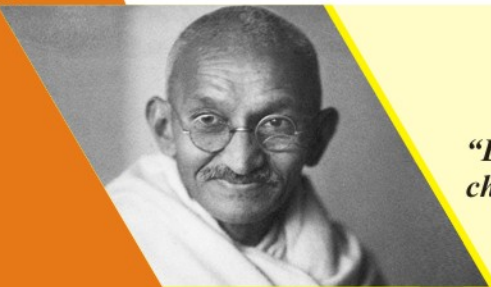

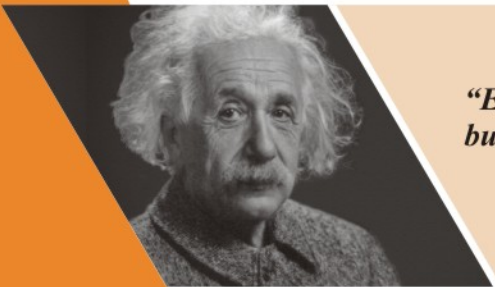

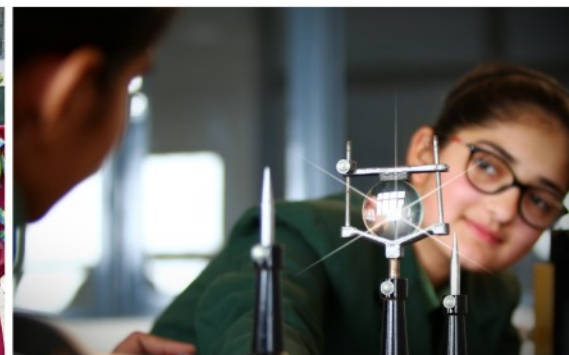

# High School

# Admission Procedure



## List of Documents required at the time of Admission

- Birth certificate as a proof of age from a Civic body.
- Aadhar Card of students.
- Educational Qualification (Degree/Diploma/Certificates of Parents).
- Residence Proof (Voter Card/Ration Card/ Passport).
- Three Passport Size Photographs of the child, mother and father.

## Admission Regulations

- The academic year begins in March and ends in February.
- No advance registration is made till 3 months prior to the prospective year of admission. Admission to the Nursery classes is taken at the minimum age of 3 Years and in Pre Nursery at the minimum age of 2.5 years. Admission will be granted only on submitting the application along with the Birth certificate from Municipal Corporation or from the Hospital Record.
- Those who seek admission to classes other than Nursery will have to bring the school certificate from the school last attended.
- Above all, the admission will be subjected to a test of capacity by means of written and oral test. Admission and assignment to a particular section of the class are entirely reserved to the school authorities.
- Parents / guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with the utmost possible accuracy. No subsequent changes will be permitted afterwards for any reason whatsoever.
- No student will be admitted without a prior test and interview.

one month notice in writing is required to withdraw the child from the school. The fee for the full calendar month will have to be paid in which the withdrawal is requested for. **However the following will not be refunded:**

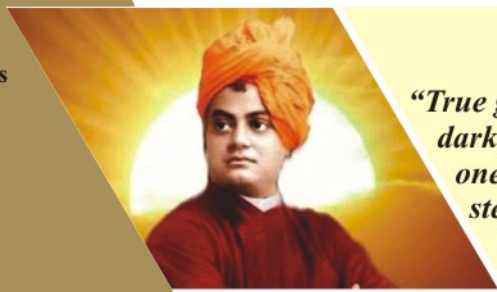

## General Information

**Keep Yourself Updated:** - In case of accidents / injury or illness at school, children are treated with first aid and every effort is made to contact the parents for instruction. Therefore it is very important that change in telephone number and addresses is to be reported to school promptly. In the event that parents cannot be reached, we will try to consult doctor on call or if condition be of not to delay, children may be hospitalized.

**Arrival at School:** The GIPS campus opens half an hour before the commencement of School. No child is allowed to arrive in school before commencement of the school.

Truant students if wish for re-admission in school, the right and decision will be reserved with Principal and they have to pay a re-admission fee of Rs. 1000/-

If your child is absent, you may request his/her homework. Kindly contact the school office (Reception) by 2.00 pm)

**Behavior Standards** All students at GIPS are expected to behave well at all times with their school mates, teachers and all school members, Behaviour that is inappropriate to the school setting, will not be tolerated. You will be notified if your child exhibits unacceptable behaviour. The school reserves all the rights to even expel a child.

**Conferences:** Good communication between parents and teacher is important part of your child's education. For keeping in view the importance of this, school organizes quarterly parent teacher conference and you are advised to spare time for this, to receive and share all information about your child. Any time you feel to communicate with teacher and are unable to wait for PTM, kindly contact the coordinators and the teachers will contact you to set up a date and time for conference. You are not allowed to go to clas rooms to have a pop - in conference with the teachers. It is necessary to carry visitor's card (guardian cards) for all visitation purpose.

### **Sports and Games:**

The Class in - charge will then transfer it to sports in charge of school. # School Rules :

## In the Campus:
